### Financial Requirement

The required amount in US currency according to the 2012-2013 Estimated Annual Expenses charts below (depending on program selection) is the amount necessary to fund tuition for program selected, fees, books, housing, food, transportation, medical insurance and other expenses. Copies of originals are not accepted. A student sponsor must submit an <u>Affidavit of Support (I-134)</u> and a notarized, current, original bank statement which shows the required balance (depending on course selection) in US currency.
