



StrataTech Debt Forgiveness Program

The StrataTech Debt Forgiveness Program (SDFP) is designed to provide assistance to eligible students who have withdrawn from school, have a previous balance owed to the school, and want to re-enter and consequently graduate from their program. This need-based program is designed to provide assistance to eligible students with demonstrated financial need based upon their difference between available resources and funding eligibility relative to their educational costs. The criterion outlined below has been designed to give the institution maximum flexibility in awarding eligible recipients. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible, students must:

- have a balance owed to the school from a prior enrollment;
- be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- apply for all applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid;
- demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process;
- complete a Debt Forgiveness Request Form;
- provide a brief essay stating why they withdrew, how they have rectified the issue(s) that resulted in their withdrawal, and how completing the program will help them reach their goals;
- maintain continuous enrollment with no lapse or break in attendance;
- maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress; and
- successfully complete their program resulting in graduation.

Award Process and Rules

- Students must apply for all available agency, state, and/or federal student aid before requesting consideration for this scholarship program.
- Each student must complete a Debt Forgiveness Request Form and write a brief essay stating why they withdrew, how they have rectified the issue(s) that resulted in their withdrawal, and how completing the program will help them reach their goals.
- Forgiveness awards are based on demonstrated need as identified through the financial aid application process.
- Only one award will be given per student.
- Maximum forgiveness amount will not exceed the amount of the debt owed to the institution.
- Forgiveness award will be awarded upon the successful completion of the reentered program.
- Forgiveness eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this award.
